

How To Use The Server: During The Tournament

- **Announcement Boards**

Think of this set of channels as a combination of the announcement boards where information is posted & the announcements volunteers would make out loud if we were all in the same building!

- **general-announcements:** Watch this space for reminders of when rounds are about to start, instructions from hosts when you can join a Zoom call, updates on any delays, etc. All round allocations will also be posted here!
- **Event channels:** in this section you will also find six channels, one per event. There you will find:
 - The room allocations for participants
 - The judge assignments
 - Any other information from the org com that is relevant to the event!
Note: for debate, the draw and motion will be posted in the channel only after it has been announced to the teams on the Zoom call. Teams should be on the Zoom call in time for the announcement.

- **Help Desks**

The Org Com is here to help!

- **organising-committee:** This is open to Participants & Judges. If you are a participant who's not on the room allocations, or a Judge that appears twice(!); if you have any questions about your event or the schedule; or if you want anything from the org com, you can use this channel! Please do not spam us. Over 500 participants will be under our care during this tournament, so please only contact the org com if needed (for participants, this means if your head coach couldn't help you or couldn't be reached).
- **tech-support:** This is open to Participants & Judges. Please report any technical problems that are interfering with your ability to participate here. Important: If you have dropped during a round that you were participating in / judging, please get in touch with us here while you're trying to reconnect so we can help you, and make sure to give us your room number!
- **sweepstakes-tabroom & debate-tabroom:** These two channels are only visible to Judges. Please use them only when necessary (this is the equivalent of knocking on the tabroom door in a live tournament!).
- **pfa-board:** this channel is also only visible to Judges. Through this you can reach the PFA Board and the President, in case you need their support.
